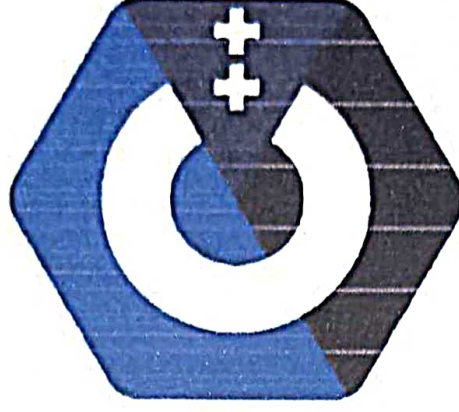

Aim of this course: Programming in C++ is a general-purpose programming and coding language. It is used in vast areas such as developing browsers, operating systems, and applications, as well as in-game programming, software engineering, data structures, etc. This course aims to help students acquainted with computer programming, algorithms, simulations of standard mathematical problems etc.

Course Description:

Programming Concepts: Algorithm and its characteristics, pseudo code/flow chart, program, identifiers, variables, constants, primitive data types, expressions, structured data types, arrays, compilers and interpreters.

Statements: Assignment statements, if then else statements, switch statements, looping statements while, do while, for, break, continue, input/output statements, functions/procedures.

Object Oriented Concepts: Abstraction, encapsulation, objects, classes, methods, constructors, inheritance, polymorphism, static and dynamic binding, overloading.

Program Development: Object-oriented analysis, design, unit testing & debugging, system testing & integration, maintenance.

“for”, “while” and “do – while” loops, break and continue statements, nested control statements, value returning functions, void functions, value versus reference parameters, local and global variables, static and automatic variables, enumeration type, one-dimensional array,

two-dimensional array, character array, pointers, structures and unions, File I/O.
