Introduction:

Turku Hansda Lapsa Hemram Mahavidyalay was established in 1stAugust 2006(Sanctioning G O is dated 27.10.2016) with a view to catering higher education to the aspiring students of a wide area surrounding Mallarpur, Birbhum. As the area is populated by a considerable percentage of socio-economically backward people and minority classes, a huge number of students of this College is literally first-generation learners. The College therefore cannot and do not avoid the responsibility of teaching a group of students lagging behind academically, socially and economically as well. With all these limitations our College, we want to claim, is not merely an addition of another number in the list of colleges in the district of Birbhum under the University of Burdwan. What we dream is that our students will acquire not degrees onlybut will improve their inner potentials also in order to contribute in the all-round development of their country andnation.

Location:

The College is situated in a plot of about 5 acre land 2 km away from Mallarpur Railway Station. At the west of it flows the irrigation Canal adjacent to the green of the Shal and Mahuya of Ganpur Forest. Twin villages - Madianand Mehednagar- exist at the south of the College and along the northern boundary of it runs NH60 fromRaniganj to Moregram. The east is open towards the horizon with the sometime green and sometime golden crops of villagers. The peaceful plot of land surrounded by the forest and agriculture is however not cut off from the outer world. It, on the contrary, is well linked with both Highway and Railway. One can easily remember in this connection that Nalanda, Texila, even Oxford, Cambridge and Tagore's Visva Bharati were once founded at the place far from the madding crowd of the Metropolis. So the place in that sense can be called favourablefor learning.
